Details

City of Newcastle (CN) is implementing a traffic or parking amendment:

As part of the traffic improvements on Glebe Road at Park Avenue, including the subsequent installation of traffic signals, and the planned restriction of the right turn into Wood Street from Glebe Road; it is necessary to install No Stopping signs on the north side of Glebe Road between the addresses of 636 and 646 Glebe Road to ensure the continued flow of traffic past this location.

The changes are necessary to meet safety requirements and prevent queues of traffic behind vehicles turning at Bourke Street that would extend through the new traffic signals and rail crossing without such treatments.

Changes will see two travel lanes provided eastbound on Glebe Road, with one used for through traffic past any vehicles turning right from Glebe Road into Bouke Street.

Changes have been supported by the Newcastle City Traffic Committee and will be implemented in advance of the completion of works on new traffic signals.
