

Western Corridor Road Upgrade

City of Newcastle has contracted Daracon to undertake this project to improve safety and ease congestion in the growing western corridor.

What work are we doing?

Upcoming work to be carried out during May includes:

- Utility service investigations
- Services relocations and installation of new services
- Installation of safety barriers and line-marking
- Temporary pavement and traffic adjustments
- Excavation for retaining walls
- Removal of topsoil for the new lanes
- Streetlight removal
- Existing kerb and roundabout demolition
- Installation of new stormwater
- Installation of parking bays

When and where we'll be working

- Longworth Avenue between the roundabout with Newcastle Road and Cameron Street
- Sandgate Road and Minmi Road and near the traffic signals at Cowper Street
- Maryland Drive to the western approach of roundabout to Summerhill Road
- The intersection of Minmi Road and Maryland Drive
- Installation of concrete parking bays on Cameron Street

Our map on the page over shows the above locations of our upcoming work.

Normal working hours are between 7am and 6pm on weekdays and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

For the safety of motorists and our workers we need to complete some construction activities out of hours. We will be working up to two nights from Sunday to Friday between **7pm to 5am**. However, our work crews may be on site from 6pm to prepare for the shift and set up safety equipment.

The following table provides further information about out of hours work planned **from Thursday 1 May to Saturday 31 May 2025**, weather permitting.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Lane closures and traffic control
- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Traffic delays may be experienced during the work

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and traffic control will be in place during the work and may affect travel times.

There may be short term intermittent stops and a temporary 40 km/h reduced speed limit outside of peak times through the work zones for the safety of motorists and workers.

Please allow for extra travel time, keep to speed limits, and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
