



Project and Works Notification

Upcoming works:

Russell Road geotechnical investigations

Russell Road, New Lambton

Commencing from:

18th August 2025

To better understand the nature of the reported landslip in the adjacent area, a geotechnical investigation is commencing at Russell Road, New Lambton.

Work will commence on 18th August 2025 from 7am and finish at 5pm. These works will occur for approximately 14 days.

Undertaking the works will have the following impacts:

- Temporary closure of the parking lane in front of 122-132 Russell Road.
- Reduced speed limit to 40km/hour in the immediate vicinity of the works area.
- Localised noise impacts in close proximity to the drilling works.

Note: The bus stop in front of 126 Russell Road will remain operational and the works will not close the footpath.

Steps that will be taken to reduce the impacts on the community include:

- Installation of safety barriers between the drilling works and the footpath.
- Provision of a dedicated traffic controller to assist with safe pedestrian movement.
- Implementation of a 40km/hour speed limit to Russell Road in the immediate vicinity of the works area.

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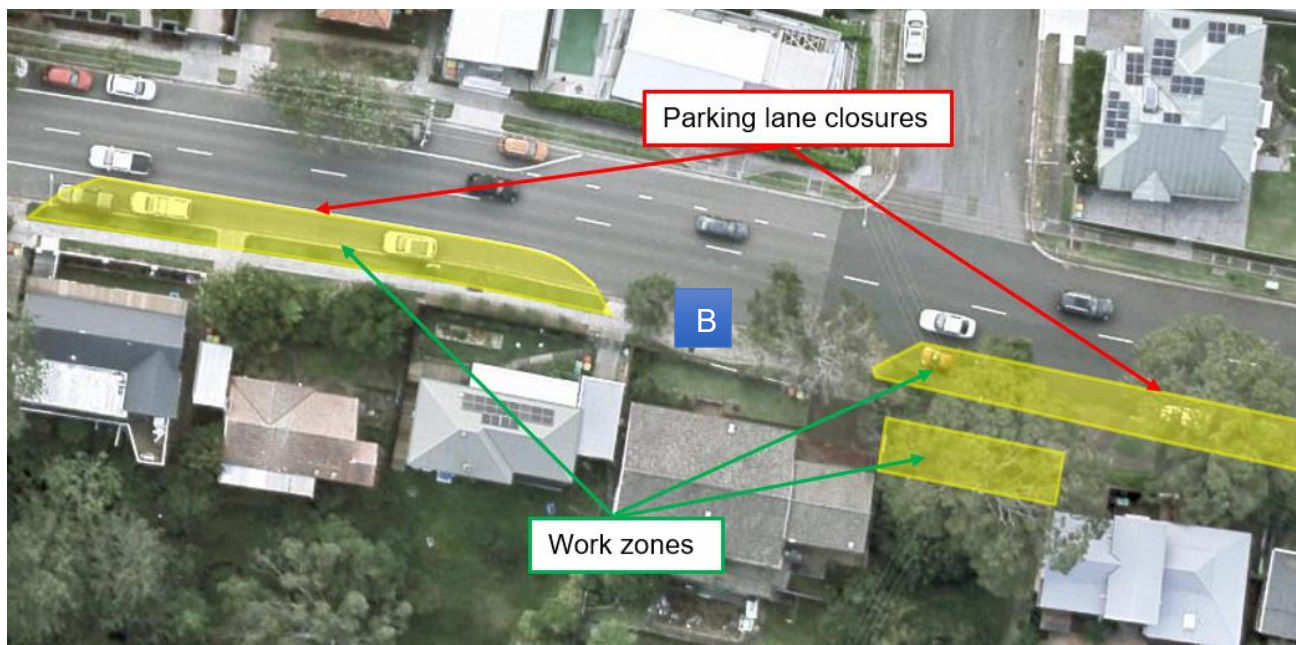
Works include:
