City of Newcastle is proposing the following:

Road Naming of Unnamed Lane in Mayfield to Bloom Lane.

These roads need to be named to facilitate addressing and to aid emergency service location and service delivery.

The new name has been pre-approved by the NSW Geographical Names Board. Members of the community are invited to view and make comment on the proposed road name.

Bloom Lane	Mayfield	<p>A name relating to the Newcastle Steelworks. A bloom is an intermediate-stage piece of steel produced by rolling in a bloom mill.</p> <p>The Newcastle Steelworks were in operation in Mayfield from 1915 to 1999. The name is inspired by the 152-hectare former steelworks, which played a significant role in Mayfield's history.</p>	The road starts at Rawson Street, Mayfield, near the northwestern corner of Lot 1 DP1272783. It extends 390m in an easterly direction, terminating at the western boundary of SP88293.

Background:

City of Newcastle (CN) is proposing a road name for one existing lane within Mayfield. CN has recently approved a secondary dwelling at 90 Sunderland Street, Mayfield (DA2024/00711), with the proposed secondary dwelling fronting the unnamed lane. This lane requires naming to facilitate addressing, to aid emergency service location and service delivery.

Submissions

- specify the grounds of support or objection.
- quote RN2025/00004 in the title of the submission; and
- include the submitter's name, address, contact number and preferably an email address.

Please note: Submissions will only be considered that directly relate to the proposed road names. Any references to the approved development are unable to be considered as part of this road naming process.
