Associated traffic changes:

Temporary shoulder closure on Cameron Street, between Douglas Street and Nash Street.

Commencing from:

19 November 2024

We will soon be upgrading the bus stop and delivering pedestrian and parking improvements along Cameron Street, between Douglas Street and Nash Street.

We anticipate completing this section of work by January 2025, depending on weather conditions.

During the works there will be some temporary changes to vehicle and pedestrian access in and around our site. The work will involve machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise the impact of this noise and ensure noisy activities do not commence before 7am. Access for residents will remain open unless otherwise communicated directly.

Works include (refer to the map on the page over):

- Temporary shoulder closure on Cameron Street (westbound) from Douglas Street to Nash Street
- Construction of off-street parking
- Construction of new footpath
- Construction of relocated transport (bus) stop adjacent to Neals Park.

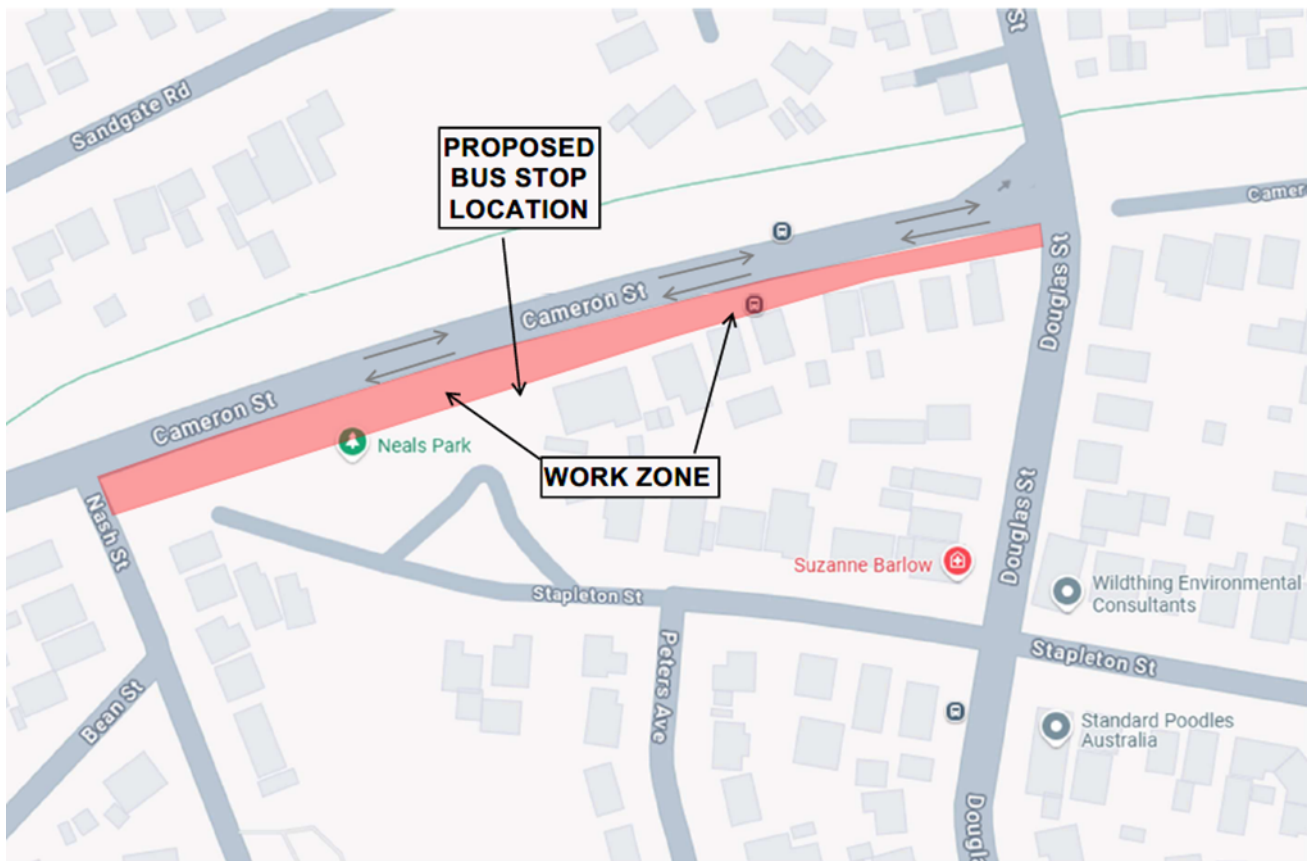
