Road naming of unnamed lane in Mayfield to **Ingot Lane**.

This road need to be named to facilitate addressing and to aid emergency service location and service delivery.

The new name has been pre-approved by the NSW Geographical Names Board. Members of the community are invited to view and make comment on the proposed road name.

Ingot Lane	Mayfield	<p>A name relating to the Newcastle Steelworks. An ingot is a manufactured piece of metal that is cast into a size and shape (usually a bar, plate or sheet) that is suitable for future processing.</p> <p>The Newcastle Steelworks were in operation in Mayfield from 1915 to 1999. The name is inspired by the 152-hectare former steelworks, which played a significant role in Mayfield's history.</p>	The road starts at Hanbury Street, near the northwestern corner of SP35118. It extends 280m in an easterly direction, terminating at Rawson Street.

## Background:

City of Newcastle (CN) is proposing a road name for one existing lane within Mayfield. CN has recently approved a secondary dwelling at 38 Sunderland Street, Mayfield (DA2025/00046), with the proposed secondary dwelling fronting the unnamed lane. This lane requires naming to facilitate addressing, to aid emergency service location and service delivery.

- specify the grounds of support or objection.
- quote RN2025/00006 in the title of the submission; and
- include the submitter's name, address, contact number and preferably an email address.

**Please note:** Submissions will only be considered that directly relate to the proposed road names. Any references to the approved development are unable to be considered as part of this road naming process.
