## **Road Naming - Unnamed Lanes in Stockton**

These roads need to be named to facilitate addressing and to aid emergency service location and service delivery. The proposed road name has been endorsed by the NSW Geographical Names Board (GNB).

Proposed Road Name	Suburb	Name Origin	Road Extent Description
Adolphe Lane	Stockton	The Adolphe was a French Barque that was built in Dunkirk in 1904. The ship sailed from Antwerp to Newcastle in 1904 and was wrecked on Oyster Bank. The bow of this Historic Shipwreck is exposed above the northern harbour breakwater, and is a feature of the Shipwreck Walk in Stockton.	The road starts at Flint Street, near the northern corner of Lot 1 DP957909. It extends south for 613m, where it terminates at an unnamed lane.
Cawarra Lane	Stockton	The Cawarra was a 552-ton paddle-steamer. built in Scotland in 1864. On 12 July 1866 it left the safety of Newcastle Harbour and was struck by heavy seas. The Cawarra sank, bow first, and claimed the lives of 60 people, with only one survivor. This shipwreck is a feature of the Shipwreck Walk in Stockton.	The road starts at Fullerton Street, near the western corner of Lot 2 DP379968. It extends east for 605m, where is terminates at Mitchell Street, Stockton.

- quote RN2025/00011 in the title of the submission; and
